Music Rules

 A music playing commitment is standard practice and mandatory for parents in all skating clubs across Canada. Parents of skaters in Excel and up (along with privates) must sign up to play music a minimum of 4 dates/session. A post-dated cheque (dated April 1, 2019) or credit card number is required with registration. Cheques will either be returned at the end of the season or cashed/credit card charged if music commitment is not fullfiled. If you are unable to fulfill your music commitment, it is your responsibility to find a replacement for your session.

Rates are as follows: 1-2 sessions = \$100, 3-4 sessions = \$150, 5+ sessions = \$200 (Boards members = 2 dates per session, skaters 19+ yrs of age are excempt from music commitment.)

• Solo music is played in order. If a skater refuses their music their name goes to the bottom of the list. Only solo's requested by a coach will be played out of order. Skaters are not permitted to request their music.

Volunteer Requirements

Volunteering is essential to our club as we are a volunteer based organization. We ask that each Skater, Parent and/or Guardian volunteer in the following ways:

- CanSkate members sign up for 1 volunteer job.
- Excel–Star 5+ members sign up for 2 volunteer jobs.
- Synchronized skating members sign up for 2 additional volunteer jobs.
- Board members sign up for 2 jobs total regardless of skater activity.

A post dated cheque (dated April 1, 2019) or credit card number for \$100/skater is required at time of registration (\$50 for CanSkate skaters). Cheques will either be returned at the end of the season or cashed/credit card charged if volunteer commitments are not fulfilled.
